

Our Reach



We Fund Culture. SCFD SCFD is the Scientific and Cultural Facilities District, a tax collected and distributed to nearly 300 cultural organizations in our seven-county Denver metro region including Adams, Arapahoe, Boulder, Broomfield, Denver, Douglas and Jefferson counties. Just one penny on every \$10 spent in the district creates vibrancy for us individually and collectively. It gives our kids a unique perspective and understanding of the world. It inspires all of us to get off the couch, discover the radical and the beautiful, and stretches our capacity to be transformed. Our metro area would not be the vibrant, nationally-ranked metropolis that it is today, without the cultural funding and economic impact created by SCFD. Residents understand this and have approved continuing the tax at each of the three renewal elections. With over \$60 million granted annually, our community is


Message from the Chair and the Director

The year of 2018 should be seen as the year that launched great change for SCFD.

This change isn't about a difference in the bedrock work we do in funding culture across the entire seven-county Denver metro area. As in the past, this year, we funded more than 280 organizations with more than \$62 million in support. Nor is the change about the access this additional funding creates from more than 100 free days annually, to reduced price tickets to the support for events and experiences from small, local opportunities to large, world class offerings. Nor is the change to the millions of people who are served by the organizations we support, including 4.3 million students, who get arts, culture and science educational opportunities. Finally, this change isn't to the outsized impact we make to our local economy with more than 11,000 jobs generated in the creative sector and more than \$500 million in economic impact.

The change we're referencing is a foundational change in the relationship we're hoping to build and nurture with the communities we serve. In 2018, we launched an effort to evolve the way we talk with our community and the way we look and feel when they see us. This effort was expressed through the work to develop a new brand for the organization after more than 30 years. This new brand is a warmer, more welcoming way of describing who we are and inviting people to engage with us. It's an effort to create language and visuals that allow each of us to find ourselves within the SCFD family. In reality, residents across the counties we serve created the district and have voted to sustain it three different times, most recently in 2016. We want them to see themselves in the district and the work we do. We want them to understand and embrace their part in our new tagline "We fund culture." Because collectively, that's exactly what we do.
