Douglas County non-profit grant opportunity

Non-profit organizations that serve Douglas County residents may be eligible for COVID-19 impact reimbursement grants funded through the County's share of the federal Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act, distributed through the Colorado Department of Local Affairs (DOLA). The program aims to reimburse nonprofit organizations a portion of the expenses incurred as they adjusted and adapted to public health restrictions and continued to serve our community while complying with COVID-19 public health order guidelines.
