Highlights from the meeting include:

- Certification reports from Denver Zoo, Denver Center for the Performing Arts, Denver Art Museum, Denver Botanic Gardens, and Denver Museum of Nature & Science
- Proclamation honoring Charlotte D'Armond Talbert, who headed the Scientific and Cultural Collaborative for many years and contributed to the health and vitality of our metro area's arts, culture and science.

Thank you to Denver Zoo for hosting the May board meeting. In 2018 Denver Zoo welcomed 290,000 guests during their SCFD free days and 46,000 guests through their \$1 admissions for families on the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP). They are managing five conservation projects and will open their new Animal hospital in 2020.
