#### **Alliance Project Grant**

Attention Teachers in K-12 public schools in Adams, Boulder, Denver, and Jefferson Counties. Grant available!

The Scientific and Cultural Collaborative (SCC) is now accepting applications for the Alliance Project Grant, a two-year grant for a team of interdisciplinary teachers at a school. These areas include Science, Social Science, Language Arts, Visual Arts, Theatre and/or Music, Dance (if available) and other areas as requested. One school selected from each of the four counties listed above. (Arapahoe, Broomfield, and Douglas counties will be eligible in the 2020/2021 School Year.) Grant serves a segment of the school, 150-180 students. Funds vary but schools can receive up to \$11,000 worth of programs, workshops, performances, field trips and assemblies from 27 arts, culture and science organizations in the Denver-Metro area who are funded by the SCFD. Plus funds assist with buses and substitute teachers. This is an incredible opportunity!
