The Collaborative of the SCFD is now accepting Alliance Grant applications from a team of interdisciplinary teachers in a K-12 Public or Charter School located in Arapahoe, Broomfield or Douglas counties. Teachers select a cohort of up to 180 students to receive a multi-year grant worth up to \$22,000 in workshops, fieldtrips, in-school exhibits and assemblies from 27 of the largest arts, science and cultural organizations in Denver-metro area!
