The SCFD Board of Directors held their August meeting in Denver County at Opera Colorado.

Highlights from the meeting include:

 Tier II organizations- regional organizations like the Arvada Center or the Children's Museum- provided their annual reports outlining the access they provide for residents and other accomplishments. There are currently 29 Tier II Organizations funded by the SCFD. The SCFD Board of Directors approved the resolution providing funding to these <u>Tier II</u> <u>organizations.</u>
